Key highlights from the May 2025 session include:

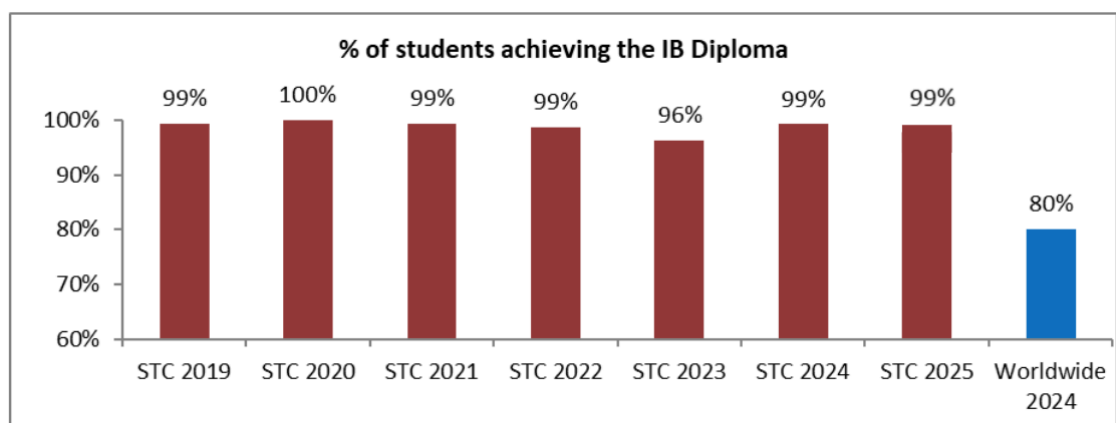
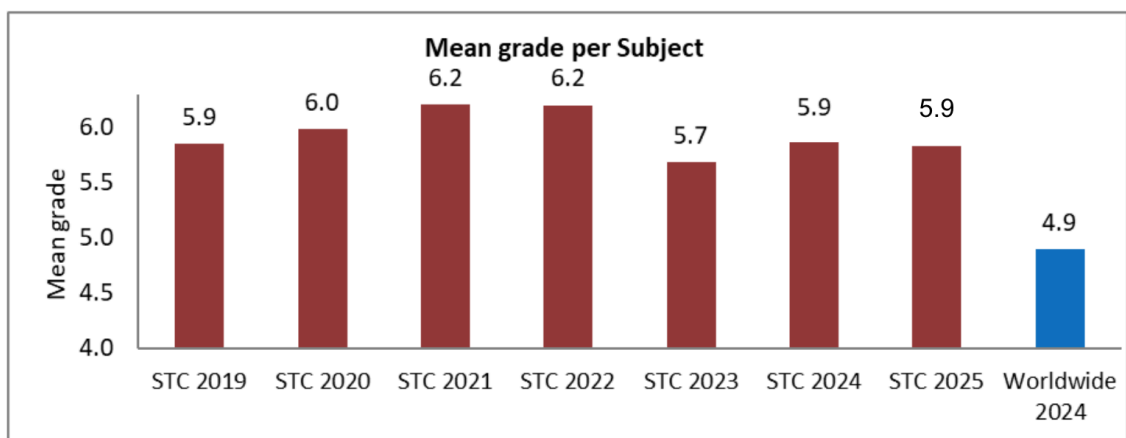
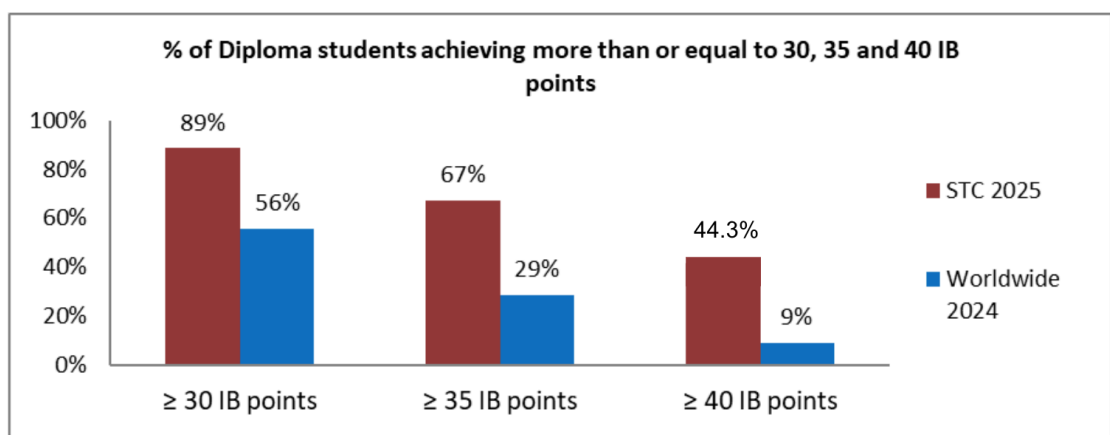
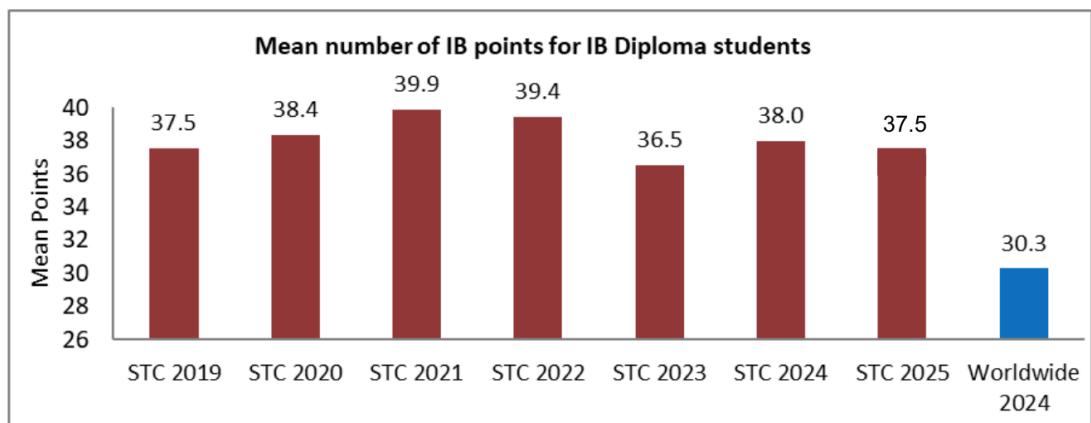
- Overall subject mean grade of 6.0
- 56% predictions spot on, 44% predictions +/- 1
- 44.3% of our students received a grade of 40 or above
