- 97% of our students were all awarded the IB Diplomas

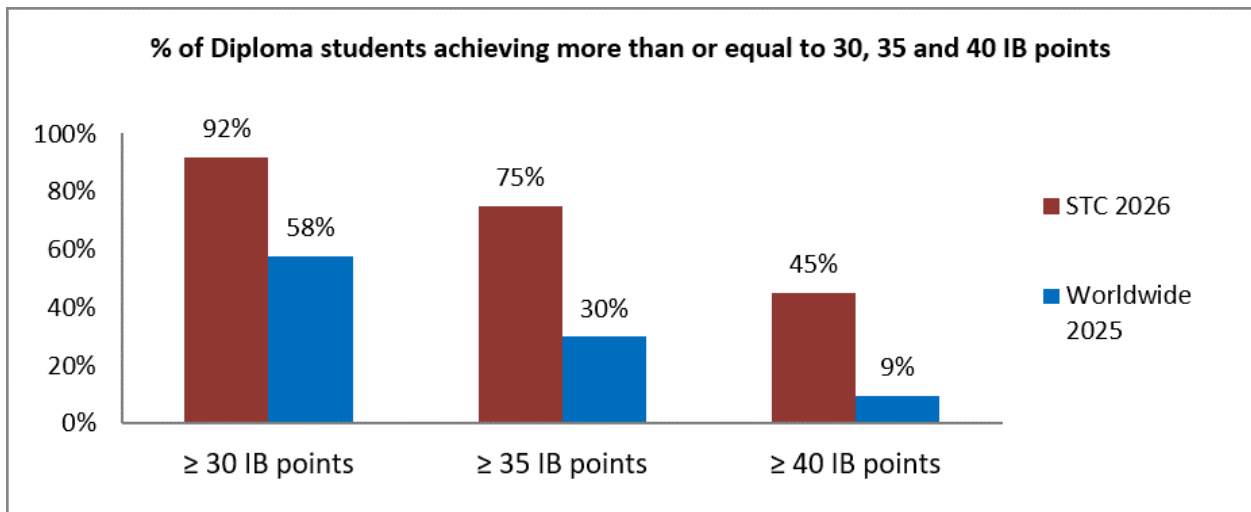
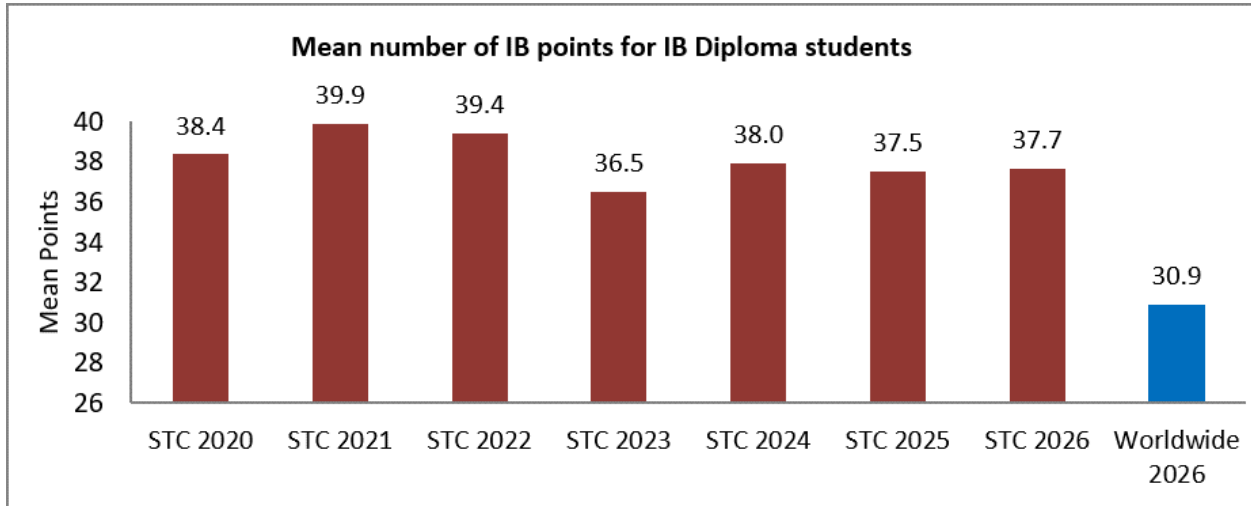
